



The Saturday Club Philanthropy Grant Application

Thank you for your interest in applying for a Philanthropy Grant from The Saturday Club. Applications are considered by the Philanthropy Committee and recommendations made for approval by The Saturday Club Board of Directors. Completed applications are due by January 15 of each grant year. Applicants will be advised of the results in March and awards are presented at the April Membership Meeting (second Tuesday in April, 7:15pm).

The Saturday Club Philanthropy Grants generally range from \$1,000 to \$5,000. We also make a limited number of in-kind donations for use of our historic Clubhouse. Applicant organizations must be a 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) designated non-profit organization and must support (with rare exception) our mission to benefit women, children, and families in our community – the greater Philadelphia area. Requests of the following nature for monetary donations will not be considered: fund-raising drives, capital campaigns, from individuals or groups of individuals, travel expenses, salaries or benefits, stipends, political activities, religious purposes.

Please include **10 individually stapled copies** of the grant application with your submission. The following documentation must be submitted with the application but are not required in duplicate:

- IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) designation documentation
- Most recent Audited Financial Statements and/or Annual Report
- Current annual Operating Budget
- Itemized Program Budget
