



MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19

- 1. Masks.** Masks are mandatory in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania when visiting businesses and when in a public space where social distancing cannot be maintained. Masks wearing is crucial to mitigating the spread of COVID-19. Please wear a mask whenever you are inside the clubhouse or if you are attending a meeting or event associated with The Saturday Club when two or more people are present and within at least 6 feet (approximately 2 arms' length). Members, visitors, and volunteers will be required to supply their own masks.
- 2. Isolate.** Screen yourself before attending any event or meeting associated with The Saturday Club. If you have any cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, sore throat, muscle pain, or new loss of taste or smell, get tested for COVID-19 and otherwise stay home and away from others. If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, quarantine at home for 14 days and do not attend any event or meeting associated with The Saturday Club. Additionally, the Pennsylvania Department of Health now requires you to quarantine at home for 14 days after travel to a state with high amounts of COVID-19 cases. - 3. Distance.** If you attend an event or meeting associated with The Saturday Club, please stay at least 6-feet apart from other attendees. All membership meetings will be live streamed via Zoom for anyone who would rather attend virtually. An invitation to attend via Zoom will be e-mailed to members prior to every meeting. In-person attendance is optional and not required for any meeting or event or to earn club credits, until further notice. If you do not feel comfortable satisfying a club credit requirement in person, please reach out to the chairperson in charge of that event to determine how to satisfy the credit virtually or on your own.
- 4. Handwashing.** Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face or eating without washing your hands. In addition to offering two sinks on the main level with soap for handwashing, The Saturday Club will be providing hand sanitizer at meetings and events.

Gloves will also be provided to volunteers working consignment sales and as needed for other events throughout the club year.

5. **Clean.** The Saturday Club is working to ensure the safety and well-being of all those who visit our clubhouse and attend our events with measures that include regularly deep cleaning our facility between meetings and events and sanitizing high traffic areas.

6. **Communicate.** The Saturday Club is monitoring the changing and evolving information regarding the COVID-19 outbreak. The safety of our membership is our primary concern. We are following the directives issued by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and our local government. We will continue to monitor health advisories and government directives pertaining to COVID-19 to ensure the safety of any meeting or event associated with The Saturday Club.
